

# Timber Sale Notice

## Burks 2023 Timber Sale

Christian County, KY

24 May 2023

### To whom it may concern:

Acting as the representative of the **Burks** property, we are offering for sale an estimated **135,000 board feet** of sawtimber lying on approximately **140 acres (estimated 110 acres)** of marked timber due to past logging activities).

### Timber Sale Location:

The timber is located in Crofton, KY in Christian County.

A map showing the location of the tract and timber is enclosed

### Timber Marked:

A summary of the marked timber is enclosed.

- Trees to be harvested were marked with **ORANGE** paint
- Sound trees to be cut were marked with three paint spots: two at 4.5 feet above ground on opposite sides and one at ground level
- Cull trees were marked with a blue "C" on one side at 4.5 feet above ground and one paint spot at ground level. Cull trees are considered less than 50% sound and no volume tally was made for them.

### Showing Date and Location:

- Date: **Monday June 5th at 9am CST** - rain or shine
- Location: 1 mile up Brinkley Store Road at the intersection of a metal farm gate (north side) and woods road (south side)

### Bid Opening:

Bidders are welcome to come and view the bid opening. Bids will be opened and read aloud.

Landowners reserve the right to accept or reject any and all bids.

- Date: **Monday June 12th at noon CST**
- Location: **Hopkinsville-Christian County Public Library, 1101 Bethel St. Hopkinsville, KY 42240**

### Bid Requirements:

- Interested parties will submit a bid using the form provided by mail, phone, email, or hand delivered at the bid opening. Bids not submitted on the required form will NOT be accepted
- All bids will be kept strictly confidential
- The timber will be sold by sealed bid
- Payment: 100% is due at contract signing

### Contract Requirements:

- Buyer will have **24 months** to cut and remove timber
- Must close on contract within two weeks of bid acceptance. Sample contract available upon request.
- Main farm roads must remain passable throughout logging operation
- Main skid roads must be graded and clear of tops and debris at conclusion of job
- Buyer and contractor shall perform all work in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws
- Buyer shall meet with Wild Indigo Forestry prior to the start of harvest to discuss road layouts, landing locations, and best management practices (BMP)
- Buyer is required to have necessary insurance and provide proof at contract signing

**TRACT LOCATION:** The tract is located in Christian County east of Crofton, KY

- Location: Brinkley Store Road off of Hwy 189 aka North Greenville Road- 3.5 miles north of Hwy 800 (see map)

**ACCESSIBILITY:** Brinkley Store Road off of Hwy 189

- Great accessibility due to the roads going to the oil pumps and tanks scattered around the property

**TOPOGRAPHY:** Rolling uplands with dry ridge tops, drains, and a blue line creek in the southern section
